

WARNING-PLEASE READ

Thank you for purchasing a quality OZtrail product. We recommend that you set up this Gazebo inner after purchase. Check that all parts are present and you familiarise yourself with the assembly and disassembly of the product. If you have any questions, your OZtrail dealer will be happy to help you.

- Gazebo and their accessories are designed as a portable and temporary structure, they are not designed to be a permanent structure.
- Do not leave Gazebos and their accessories unattended in heavy rain or wind. In rain make sure water does not pond on the canopy. The weight of the water could cause damage.
- Always secure Gazebos and their accessories firmly to the ground ensuring all peg points and guy ropes are utilised and remain firm. In heavy rain or winds remove the canopy and all accessories to avoid damage.
- Do not fold up the Gazebo with the canopy or accessories still attached as this could cause damage.

INNER KIT ATTACHMENT INSTRUCTIONS

Step 1 Clearing the Site

Under the Gazebo clear a level area of all stones, twigs, etc.

Step 2 Laying out the Gazebo inner kit

Unpack the contents of your Gazebo inner kit. Unfold the fabric and layout with the floor against the ground and the wall and roof fabric facing up.

Step 3 Pegging out the floor

On each corner of the floor there is an elasticised hook attached to the floor. Connect this hook to the base of the frame upright poles. Located mid way alone the side of the floor there are peg out webbing loops. With the pegs provided peg out these webbing loops firm but not tight.

Step 4 Standing up the Gazebo inner kit

On each corner of the roof there is an elasticised hook attached to the roof. Connect this hook to the top of the frame upright poles. Located mid way alone the edge of the roof there are "J" hooks on webbing loops. Connect these "J" hooks to the scissor action struts of the Gazebo frame. Mid way up the wall corners there are ties. Wrap these ties around the frame upright poles and tie together, firm but not tight.

INNER KIT PACK UP INSTRUCTIONS

Simply reverse the above attachment instructions.
