ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

OZtrail advises to assemble your Shelter before use to ensure all parts are present and to become familiar with the assembly of your shelter.

- Choose a flat level area with no objects that could damage the floor. Layout out the shelter facing the desired direction.
- 2. Peg out the four corners of the shelter floor. Anchor the shelter to the ground by inserting the pegs through the ring loops at each corner of the floor at an angle of 45 degrees. Firm but not tight. As you work from one peg point to the other around the shelter base pull the floor firmly, but not tight. Assemble the poles ensuring each pole section is firmly secured into the next.
- 3. Select the long pole and slide it through the pole sleeve that run across the top of the front opening from side to side. With the remaining pole slide through the pole sleeve that runs across the rear wall from side to side. Connect the pole ends onto the corresponding pin and ring assemblies at the base of the shelter (see photo of shelter), the poles will arch and the shelter will stand up during this step.
- Connect the J-Hooks attached to the shelter onto the poles. Ensure the shelter remains securely anchored at all times.

NOTE: In severe conditions the shelter should be dismantled.

DISASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

To pack away, simple reverse the above.
