IMPORTANT

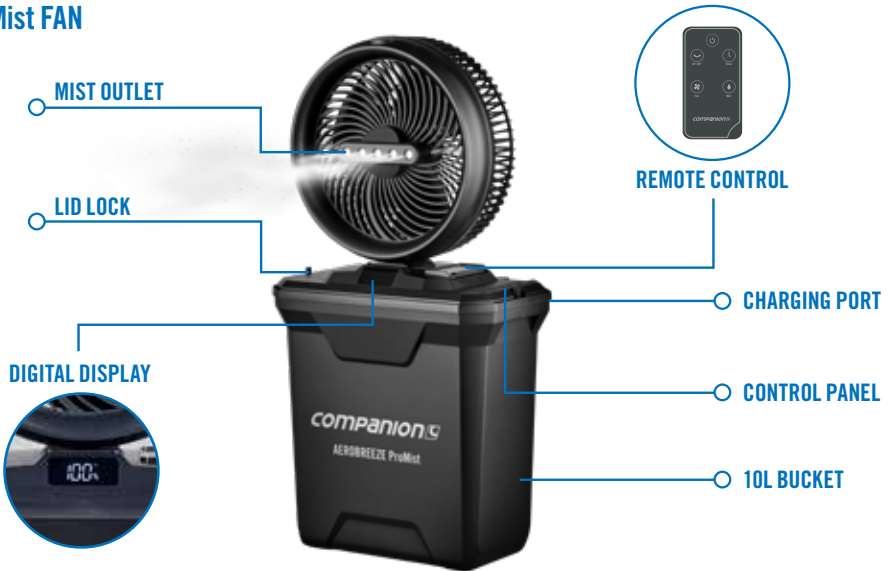
- Please read this instruction manual carefully before operating the unit.
- To maximise battery life, it is recommended to fully charge the battery every three months.

SAFETY INFORMATION

- This unit is not intended for use by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities or lack of experience and knowledge.
- Children must be supervised at all times when around this unit.
- Place unit in a well ventilated area when in use or recharging the battery.
- Do not attempt to disassemble or replace the batteries.
- To be repaired by qualified persons only - contact Customer Service on 1300 362 921.
- Do not expose to heat source, rain or submerge in liquid.
- If charging cords become damaged, they must be replaced by a qualified person.
- Do not damage the USB cable, forcefully bend it, pull it, twist it, or use it if frayed or broken.
- Do not use the USB cable or plug if dust has collected or the Type-C connection is loose.
- Do not use with anything other than the dedicated USB cable.
- Do not use near fire or in high-temperature areas.
- If the unit is damaged, stop use immediately and contact Customer Service on 1300 362 921.
- Ensure the USB cable connector is fully inserted and not loose.
- Use only the included USB cable for charging.
- This product is for household use only. Do not use for commercial purposes.
- Do not use in places where it may come in contact with rain.
- Do not use if the product is cracked, deformed, or damaged.
- Do not bring face or hair close to the fan outlet or air intake.
- Do not use near materials that easily get sucked in (e.g. curtains, thin cloth, etc).
- Do not drop or subject the unit to strong impact.
- When unplugging the USB cable, always hold the connector - do not pull on the cord.
- Use and store the product in a location with temperature between -10°C and 40°C.

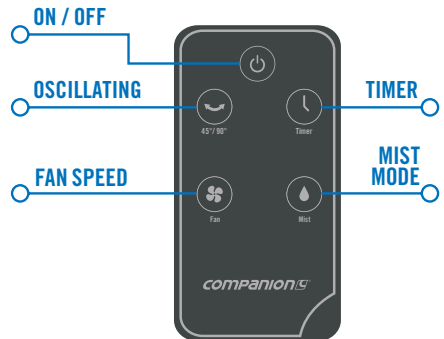

REMOTE CONTROL

- Step 1.** Remove the plastic pull tab from the remote control before use.
- Step 2.** The remote control range is less than 3 metres.
- Step 3.** Ensure that the transmitting signal of the remote control is aimed at the receiver.

TO CHARGE

- Step 1.** Connect the USB cable (included) to the fan’s Type-C port, and the other end to a USB port on an AC adapter (not included) or a power source.
- Step 2.** A green lightning bolt will flash on the digital screen while charging.
- Step 3.** Once completely charged, the display will show 100% and the green lightning bolt will always be on.



OPERATION

The fan can be operated with and without the remote control. The below steps apply to both operation methods.

FUNCTION		OPERATION
	Fan Button	Press F1-F4 to cycle through fan speeds. Press again to turn off. Digital display shows the battery level. Fan can be used without the misting function.
	Mist Button	Press P1 (1 misting jet), P2 (3 misting jets), P3 (5 misting jets), press again to turn off mist.
	Timer Button	Press 1H, 2H, 4H, 8H or 0H (no timer set). Timer can only be set while in operation. Once turned off, the fan will revert to no timer.
	Oscillation Button	45°/90° oscillation. Returns to starting position once the fan is turned off. Oscillation only operates when fan and misting functions are on.
	Power Button	Press and hold the power button for 2 seconds to turn all functions off.

FILLING THE WATER TANK

Step 1. To unlock the Lid Locks on both sides of the unit, align both locks so they are parallel to the fan (Fig 1).

Step 2. Remove the fan lid.

Step 3. Fill the reservoir with fresh clean water. DO NOT add any aromatic oils, etc.

Step 4. Replace the fan lid.

Step 5. Lock the Lid Locks on both sides of the unit, align both locks so they are vertical to the fan (Fig 2).

Step 6. To empty the reservoir, reverse the above steps. To remove remaining water from the hose, turn the misting function on for 10 seconds. Ensure that the fan and reservoir are completely dry before storing.

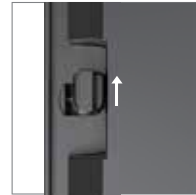

TIPS

Only use clean fresh water. DO NOT add impurities, essential oils, perfumes or other liquids as they may clog the misting jets.

CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS

Step 1. Ensure unit is switched off and disconnected from a power source before cleaning.

Step 2. Clean with a damp cloth only.

Step 3. DO NOT use any abrasive cleaners or harsh chemicals.

Step 4. Ensure all components are completely dry before storing the unit.

TROUBLESHOOTING



ISSUE	CAUSE	SOLUTION
Fan does not turn on	Battery is low or not charged	Charge the unit with the included USB cable
Blades are spinning, but no wind	Dust or debris has accumulated around the fan or motor	Clean the fan thoroughly
Fan / misting stops during use	Battery is drained	Recharge the battery fully before reuse
Misting jets are not working	Misting jets are blocked	Clean the misting jets thoroughly
Fan speed dropped to Level 3 unexpectedly	Battery is below 10%	When the battery is below 10%, fan is on high and spray is at max, the fan will drop to Level 3 and misting will remain. Charge battery to increase fan speed
Unusual noise during operation	Debris is caught in the fan	Turn off the unit and remove the debris safely
Remote control is not working within 3 metres of fan	Remote control battery is flat	Replace the battery (Battery type: CR2025)
Remote control is not working	Remote control is further than 3 metres from the fan	Move closer to the fan
